- **2.** Individuals and teams must be available at the commencement of the session for marshalling and competition of an event listed.
- **3.** All events are time finals.
- **4.** This is a draft programme and subject to change.
- 5. Order of events will be: 1 Open Male; 2 Open Female; 3 Youth Male; 4 Youth Female, 5 Nipper Male and 6 Nipper Female
- 6. Only use the lanes allocated. Keep social distances in the pool and outside the pool at all times.
- 7. No parents, no siblings and or spectators other than the officials, coaches and chaperones will be allowed access.
- 8. <u>No entry</u> to the facility will be allowed without a mask or if your name is not on the Covid Register.
- 9. At the pool entrance each day:
 - Your temperature will be taken.









- You have to complete the compulsory Covid Register.
- You have to submit your health monitoring form at the entrance (See attached)
- **10.** <u>Social distancing</u> of 2 m between 2 people is compulsory at all times Team Managers/Chaperones to help monitoring social distances & wearing of mask by Provincial athletes.
- **11.** Athletes to always wear their own <u>face mask</u> when not participating in their events. (Face mask to be stored in clearly market Ziploc bag in the kit bag and not to be left lying around.)
- 12. Athletes are not to spit; any coughing or sneezing is to be done into a tissue and immediately disposed of.
- **13.** No eating will be allowed in the marshal area.
- **14.** Equipment Manikins will be provided. No other equipment will be shared.
- **15.** The use of <u>communal change rooms</u> to be kept to a minimum.
- **16.** No smoking in the pool arena Smoking will only be allowed outside.
